Eyes closed, heart open - she gives herself completely to the moment.

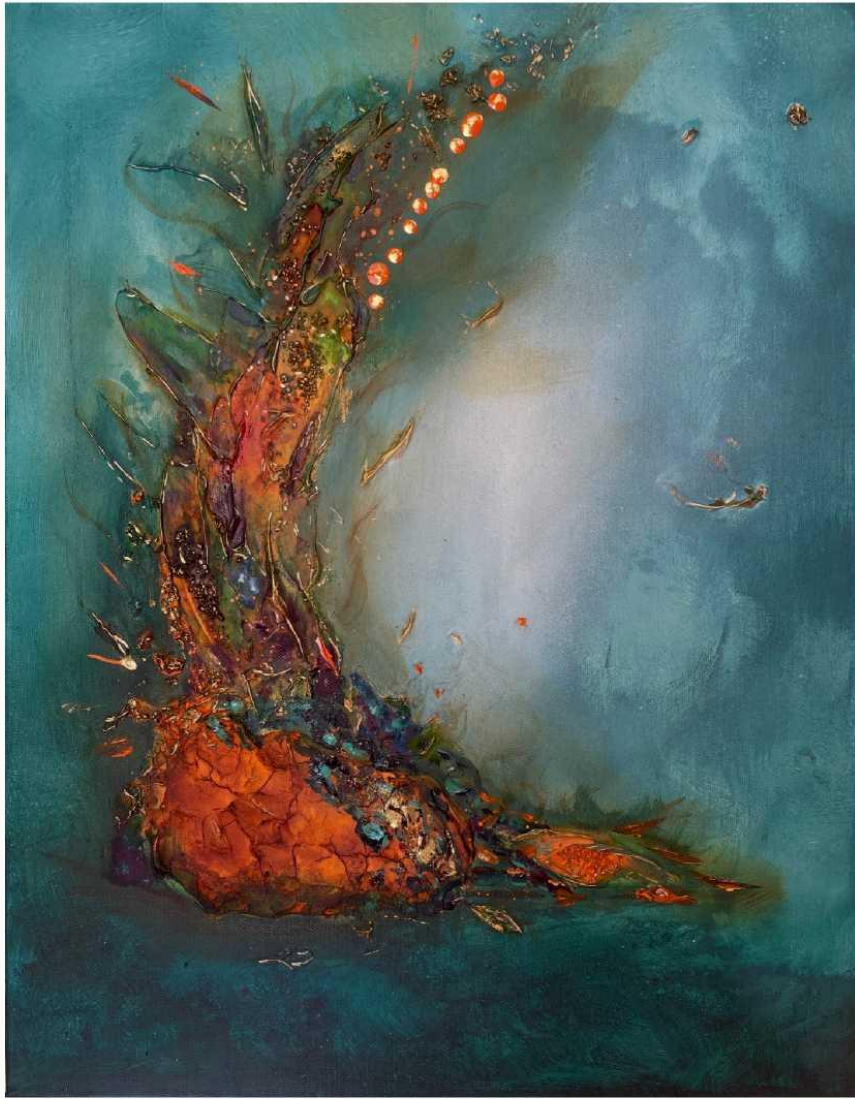
There is warmth in her, movement, laughter, and that delicious sense of

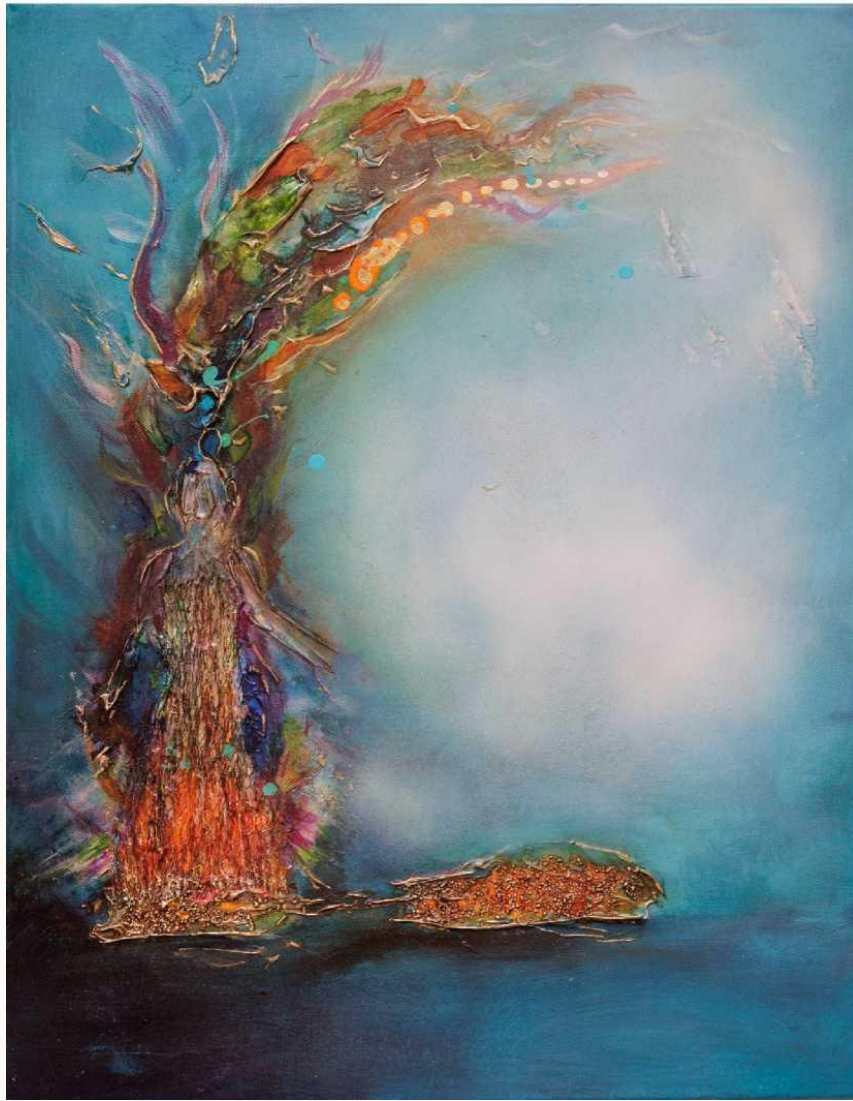
Some stories never disappear. They simply sink beneath the surface and wait.

A place to pause, reflect, and simply be.

Below, the still water catches their reflection, turning the moment into
something almost dreamlike.

And sometimes, all we need to do is look up.
